

GCWA 2004 ANTHOLOGY VOL. IV

Guidelines

- 1. Open to members of GCWA in good standing only.
- 2. Deadline for submissions: Sept.30, 2004.
- 3. Any genre—No op-ed pieces will be accepted.
- 4. GCWA has firsts right only. Copyright and all other rights remain author's property.
- 5. Maximum of 30 pages (or 7500 words) Double Spaced, Single Side.
- 6. If more submissions received than anthology can accommodate, first come, first served rule will apply.
- 7. Standard Manuscript Format. Do not staple submissions.
- 8. If possible, submit on floppy (IBM formatted), otherwise send hard copies (typed), no handwritten copies accepted. Anthology will use Times New Roman 12. Do NOT use smaller font.
- 9. Graphics, drawings, artwork, must be submitted on disc. These will be returned after anthology is published.
- 10. All work will be checked for spelling, grammar and punctuation. If more than 10 errors are found, MS will be returned to author for corrections.
- 11. As with prior anthologies, GCWA requests each author purchase one copy of published anthology.
- 12. No excessive violence or gratuitous sex.
- 13. Only original, unpublished (includes newsletters) submissions. (Author will attest to this in writing.)
- 14. The Anthology Committee reserves the right to reject any submission it deems contrary to its wishes.
