

2020 GUIDELINES FOR GCWA WRITING CONTEST

- Writing Contest is open to GCWA members and the public.
- All entries should be mailed to:

- Original, unpublished submissions only (see formatting requirements below):
 - Your entry must be original, in English, unpublished, and unproduced, not accepted by any other publisher or producer before April 1, 2020.
- Word count:
 - o Fiction / Nonfiction / Children's —1500 words maximum
 - o Poetry 40 lines maximum
- Nonfiction includes essay, memoir, and creative nonfiction.
- Youth submissions (ages 11-17) will be judged separately.
- Submit **three** (3) **copies**. Your submission(s) will not be returned.
 - o Note: Fewer than six (6) entries in a category may constitute no contest in which case entry fees shall be returned.
- Student or youth submissions requires current identification of school where actively enrolled.
- All entry fees are due in U.S. Dollars, accompanied by an entry form.
- Deadline:
 - o Entries postmarked after January 31, 2020, will not be accepted.
- If you submit a portion of a novel, please understand that it will be judged as a complete story.

- All Judges' decisions are final.
 - o Judges will consider: characterization, plot, structure, spelling, grammar and punctuation. Visit our Website https://gulfwriters.org/contest/ for judging criteria forms.
 - O Judges reserve the right to NOT select a winner if entries fail to meet quality criteria.
- Winner notification: by US mail and email before March 31, 2020
- The winning submissions (top three in each category) will be published on GCWA's Website (& possibly the Ft Myers Magazine) with author permission.
 - o GCWA has only first rights. Copyright and all other rights remain property of author.
 - o Winners will be announced at the GCWA meeting in April, 2020
- You may enter as many submissions as you like in each of the following categories:
 - o Fiction, Nonfiction, Poetry, Children's.
 - o No gratuitous violence or erotica.
- Typed submissions only (handwritten submissions will be disregarded), 3 copies.

- o Font: Times New Roman, Font size: 12
- o Margins: top/bottom 1", left/right 1", text unjustified (ragged right margin).
- o Fiction/ Nonfiction/Children's: double spaced, single side on 8 ½ x 11 white paper. Indent first line of paragraphs.
- o No illustrations for Children's.
- o Poetry may be single or double spaced as best befits the work.
- o Judging is done by blind entry method. (DO NOT INCLUDE YOUR NAME ON ENTRY SUBMISSION PAGES.)
- o You must include the title of your entry on each page.
- o All pages must be numbered bottom center of page.
- o Children's entries should list intended age level at top of page.
- o Each of your three copies of entries must be stapled in top left corner.
- Entry form:
 - Entry form should NOT be stapled to entry (Judging by blind entry method)
 - o Author's name (Pen names are allowed. We only need your real name if you are chosen as a winner in order to issue prizes.)
 - o You must complete one entry page for each piece/entry (3 copies) entered.
 - o Each form must include your full mailing address, email, and telephone number, title of work, submission category, and word count.

Note: If there are not enough Children's submissions, they will be combined with Fiction.
