- No more than 30 lines
- You may submit more than one poem
- You must submit via email
- Deadline for submissions is February 26

- "Poetry" should be in subject line
- Add **two** attachments
- 1st attachment Your identifying information: name, phone
 #, email address and the <u>title</u> of poem
- 2nd attachment the poem, including its title, the title of the painting that inspired you and the artist's name (not the poet's name!)
- No identifying information about the poet may be on the poem itself or the poem may be disqualified.
- You will receive an email confirmation when we have received the poem. If you do not receive a confirmation in 48 hours, contact Dorothy Brooks, 941-661-4607.

Those selected to participate in the reading will be notified by phone or email on or before **March 2, 2020**.
