Now, on **Friday Jan. 24, at 7:30 p.m.** friends of Friday Stories for Grownups will come to THE COMMUNITY HOUSE where Dr. Simon will tell highlight stories from that first year, 2002, and right up through 2019. .



Story Telling came easy to this veteran Teacher with 40 years of using stories in his classes. He was nominated as Teacher of the Year at the University of Massachusetts where he spent the last 25 years of his career.

Simon became internationally known for his work in Values Clarification and earned a place on **The Oprah Show** and Sid and his son, John, appeared on the **Phil Donahue Show**. He was a keynote speaker at **The Betty Ford Center** in California and traveled all over the U.S., Canada and 7 countries in Europe delivering workshops. His book **VALUES CLARIFICATION. (A Handbook of Practical Strategies for Teachers, Counselors and Students )** was widely popular. There were **600,000 copies in print.**
