You may take a photograph of the inspiration piece, but please let the Front Desk person know you are taking it for the poetry submission. They have strict policies regarding no photographs, but are making an exception for the poetry event. Ten poems will be selected from those submitted by a committee chosen by the Visual Arts Center. Each of these poems will be read by the poet at the event on Wednesday, March 23, 2022.

#### Rules

- Poems must be in 12 pt. text in .doc or .docx format
- No more than 30 lines
- You may submit more than one poem
- You must submit via email
- Deadline for submissions is March 15
- There is no fee to enter  $\bigcirc$

### Entry Instructions

Entry is anonymous, so please follow instructions carefully:

- "Poetry" should be in subject line
- Add <u>two</u> attachments
- 1<sup>st</sup> attachment Your identifying information: name, phone number, email address and the <u>title</u> of poem
- 2<sup>nd</sup> attachment the poem, including its title, the title of the painting that inspired you and the artist's name (not the poet's name!)
- No identifying information about the poet may be on the poem itself or the poem may be disqualified.
- You will receive an email confirmation when we have received the poem. If you do not receive a confirmation in 48 hours, contact Dorothy Brooks, 941-661-4607.

Those selected to participate in the reading will be notified by phone or email on or before **March 21, 2022**.
